<u>AASHE Launches Online Reporting Tool for Campus GHG Emissions</u>

As part of its support for the American College & University Presidents Climate Commitment, AASHE has created an online tool for signatories to report on their GHG emissions. The new tool, which is integrated with the tool for submitting two-month reports, also includes new data about the tangible actions that signatories have committed to implement. Finally, the tool also includes a directory of ACUPCC Implementation Liaisons.

### 4. New Report on Climate Action Planning from NWF

The National Wildlife Federation Campus Ecology Program and SCUP have released a new report: "Guide to Climate Action Planning: Pathways to a Low-Carbon Campus." This guide addresses a simple question: How can colleges and universities significantly reduce their greenhouse gas emissions quickly and cost effectively? Reducing emissions without a climate action plan is like constructing a building without a blueprint – the outcome is unlikely to meet the original goals in a timely manner. The report is a comprehensive review of the strategies and steps to reduce greenhouse gas emissions on campus, with best practices from U.S. colleges and universities.
